Swachhata Pakhwada October 2

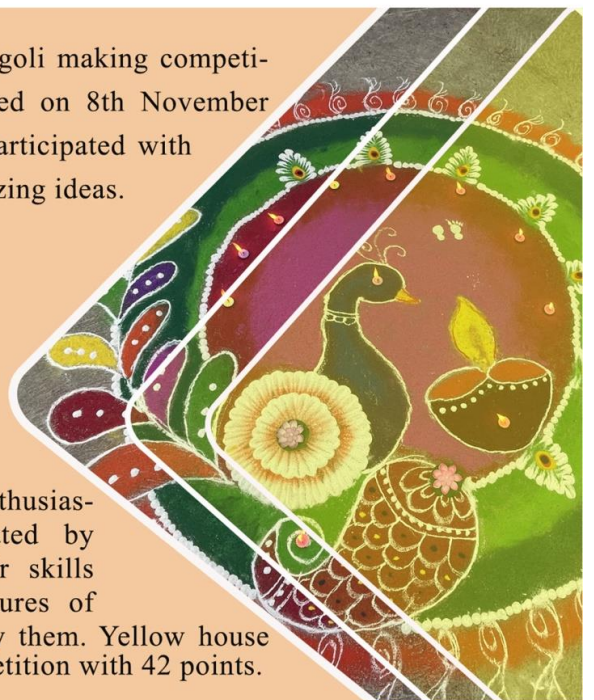
