the best education possible. They will work with you to help you reach your full potential and achieve your goals.

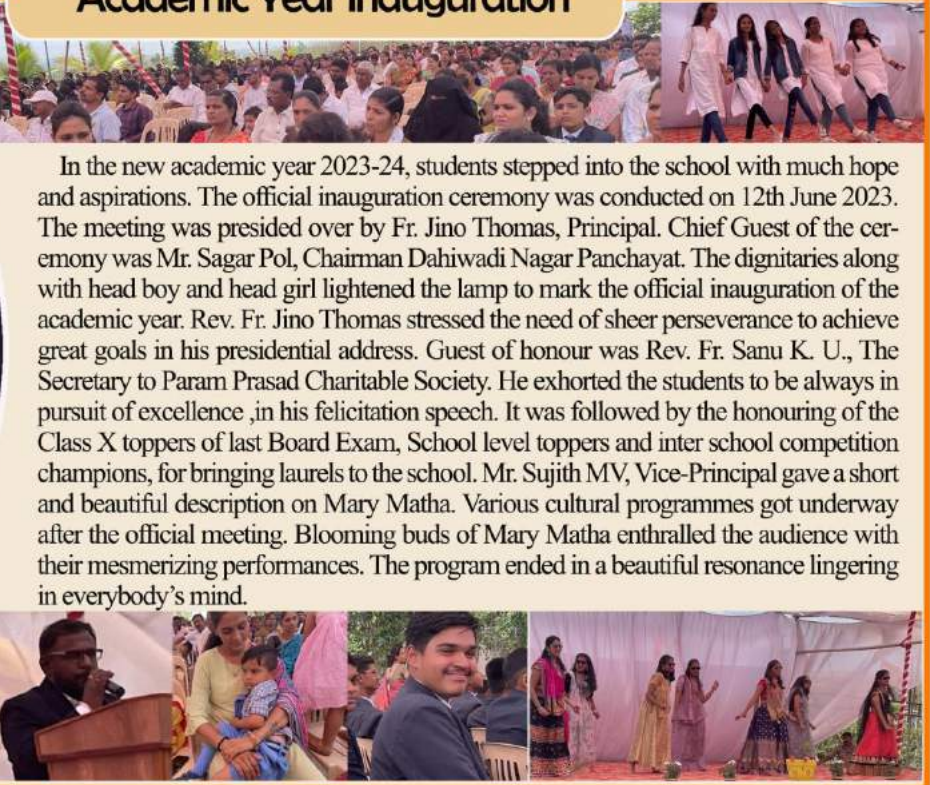
